HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondent No.4 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger at the hands of respondent No.4. The certificate evidencing their marriage is on record as Annexure P-3. Petitioner No.2 has submitted a representation dated 24.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Harkanwar Jeet Singh, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, to decide the representation dated 24.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) of petitioner No.2 and grant protection to the petitioners, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived.

It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
