This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for the issuance of directions to the respondents to transfer the husband of the petitioner from Central Jail Bathinda to Central Jail, Ludhiana or any other jail.

Learned counsel for petitioner has submitted that in the present case, the petitioner has given a representation dated 16.11.2022 (Annexure P-6) to respondent No.3, detailing her grievance and she would be satisfied in case the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-the Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda, to look into the said representation (P-6) and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Notice of motion to the respondents.

On advance notice, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab,

accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and on a specific query put by this Court, he has stated that there is no legal right with the petitioner to seek transfer from one jail to another and has submitted that he has no objection in case, respondent No.3-Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda, considers the representation (Annexure P-6) and takes appropriate action, in accordance with law.

Keeping in view of the above-said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda to consider the representation dated 16.11.2022 (Annexure P-6) and take appropriate action, in accordance with law.

It is made clear that this Court has not given any opinion on the merits of the case and it would be open to respondent No.3 to consider representation (P-6) independently and take action in accordance with law.
