Petitioner in his private capacity has filed the instant petition seeking mandamus directing the Assistant Commissioner, Directorate General of Vigilance, Indirect Taxes & Customs, New Delhi to conduct and carry out investigation on a complaint dated 25.03.2019 (Annexure P-15) that had been made against the officials of the Customs Departments in relation to certain consignment.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length and having perused the pleadings on record, we are of the considered view that no basis for interference to accept the prayer under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is warranted.

Petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to pursue his grievance/prayer with the respondent-authorities.
