The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing the respondents No.5 to 8 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted representations dated 01.12.2022 (Annexures P-5 and P-6) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala and the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, and she shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondents No.2 & 3, to look into their representations dated 01.12.2022 (Annexures P-5 & P-6).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala and

respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mohali, are directed to depute a senior officers to look into the matter and after seeking a report, they may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

This order shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the parties. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.

With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
