The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been preferred by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 30.04.2019, passed by Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Amritsar through which she had been declared a proclaimed person in case FIR No.249 dated 11.10.2016 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

Over two years and two months ago, on 04.12.2019, while adjourning the matter to 18.12.2019, to show her *bonafides*, this Court had directed the petitioner to appear before the Trial Court with a further direction to the Trial Court that in case she puts in appearance before it, she be released on interim bail to the Trial Court's satisfaction.

In terms of the afore referred order of this Court, the petitioner failed to put in appearance before the Trial Court and on request made on her behalf this Court granted her another opportunity to do so. However, the petitioner again did not appear before the Trial Court and this Court, showing benevolence, granted another opportunity to the petitioner to do the needful.

Today, over two years and two months have elapsed but the petitioner has failed to appear before the Trial Court.

In view of the above deplorable conduct of the petitioner, she has disentitled herself for any relief.
