Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is more than one prayer made in the present petition including the quashing of the advertisement and subsequent proceedings of the selection process and he has instructions not to press the said prayer any further and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners competed for the post in question as advertised vide Advertisement No.12 of 2019 but now the petitioners are being declared ineligible on the ground that the petitioners do not have the specific diploma as required.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that keeping in view the instructions issued by the Government of Haryana, diploma possessed by the petitioners is to be treated equivalent to the qualification

advertised, hence, once the petitioners have been allowed to participate on the basis of said diploma, now declaring them ineligible at the time of declaration of result, is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that without approaching the authorities concerned with regard to the grievance as raised in the present petition, the petitioners have approached this Court which render the petition not maintainable.

Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case, the grievance raised by the petitioners is raised before the authorities concerned, due consideration will be given to the said grievance and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such grievance from the petitioner's side.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation.

Ordered accordingly.
