AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents (arrayed in the petition), who have solemnised marriage against the wishes of their parents.

Representation dated 1.12.2022 was sent through registered post.

Learned State counsel appearing on advance notice on instructions submits that the mobile numbers of the petitioners mentioned in the petition are switched off and they are not available at the given address. The contention is that if they approach the police authorities, needful would be done expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would approach the office of the SSP concerned.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are called for.

The petition is disposed of.

It is clarified that this court has not commented on the validity of marriage and age of the petitioners.
