1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 23.07.2019 in CWP No.4389 of 2017.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 23.07.2019 reveals that CWP No.4389 of 2017 was disposed of by directing the claim of the petitioner to be considered for appointment on compassionate basis in accordance with the existing Policy governing the issue in terms of decision dated 22.02.2019 in CWP No.16880 of 2014.

3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to order Annexure P-1, the petitioner has been given appointment on compassionate basis though not with effect from the date in terms of the policy applicable, therefore in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to take out proceedings in accordance with law for grant of compassionate

4. The proposed course of action is not opposed to by learned counsel for the respondent.

5. Accordingly, in the circumstances, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent. The contempt petition is disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
