The instant petition has been filed on behalf of the Suman Chaudhary has been received by the Secretariat of the Hon'ble Chief Justice wherein it has been alleged that on 11.11.2019 at about 6:00 P.M., complainant's husband Ramesh Chaudhary had been taken away by 5-6 persons whose identity was not known to her and they had taken the car of her husband bearing No. HR-70-C-3090.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that final report of the Special Investigation Team in FIR No. 114 dated 12.11.2019 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station, Special Task Force filed along with the affidavit of Sukhamrit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Special Task Force Unit, Patiala is already a subject matter of challenge in a separate CRM-M-12828-2020. It is also pointed out that another CRM-M-6146-2021 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking

transfer of the trial.

He contends that in view of the petitioner having already taken recourse to the alternative remedies, he does not wish to press the present petition and seeks permission to withdraw the same with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid and to raise all pleas/issues in CRM-M-12828-2020.
