This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to refund the share of the petitioners contributed by them towards New Defined Contributory Pension Scheme along with interest @ 18% per annum as per the mandate of judgment passed by this Court in *CWP No.35361 of 2019*, titled as *Constable Bikramjit Singh and others versus State of Punjab and others*, decided on 30.03.2022.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer to the extent that the representation dated 22.08.2022 (Annexure P-11), served upon the respondents should be decided expeditiously. He would submit that the petitioners would be satisfied in case the said representation is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Mohit Kapoor, Addl. A. G., Punjab, who is also present in Court, accepts notice for the respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioners. Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper-book be supplied to him, during the course of the day.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 22.08.2022 (Annexure P-11) of the petitioners, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioners. In case of failure to do so, the official responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
