The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 58 dated 28.03.2022 under Sections 21(c), 25 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 read with Section 25 of the Arms Act (Sections 379, 411 and 489 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Special Task Force, STF Wing, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is to get married on 16.01.2023 and thus, states that he may be permitted to move an application for interim bail before the trial Court and the same be considered as expeditiously as possible in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

In case, petitioner moves an application for interim bail on the ground of his marriage within a period of 4 days from today, then the trial Court is requested to decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 5 days after filing of such application.
