[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 17.10.2022 in CRWP No.9799 of 2022 in case titled as Joybir Singh Kataria vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CRWP No.9799 of 2022 was disposed of vide order dated 17.10.2022 by directing respondent No.1 herein to consider and decide representation dated 03.10.2022 himself or through any other officer of the IPS cadre by passing a speaking/reasoned order within thirty working days and to communicate decision thereon to the petitioner without delay.

[3] Learned AAG has produced report dated 18.11.2022 submitted by the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Law and Order, Jalandhar duly approved by the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in view of the needful having been done by the

respondents in terms of order, Annexure P/1, he has instructions from the

petitioner to state that the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge report dated 18.11.2022 to the extent the same is adverse to the interest of the petitioner.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instantpetition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
