The petitioner has approached this Court by submitting that there is a proposed 15% cut on his pension in violation of Rule 2.2 Volume II of the Punjab Civil Services Rules. An appeal has been filed against the said order imposing the cut. The prayer made is for staying the operation of any recovery or further cut till the appeal is decided.

It is submitted that the petitioner has been issued charge-sheet, post retirement, for the occurrence that took place in the year 2017. It is contended that the said charge-sheet has been issued without the concurrence of the Head of the Department i.e. Board of Director, which is against the provisions of the Punjab Civil Service Rules.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Kirti Ahuja, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Let sufficient number of copies of complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

In view of the very limited prayer made, the present writ petition is disposed of by giving a direction for the appeal to be decided expeditiously by the authority concerned and till such time as the appeal is not decided, the imposition of the cut or any recovery imposed upon the petitioner shall remain stayed.
