By this common order, three writ petitions, the details of which have been given under heading, are being disposed of as all the three writ petitions involve same question of law and on similar facts.

The petitioners who are working as Guest Faculty Teachers have approached this Court challenging their transfer on the ground that as per the transfer policy, the Guest Teachers who were displaced by a regular employee, were to be adjusted at the available vacant stations whereas, now the petitioners are being dislodged to accommodate the other Guest Faculty Teachers, which is not envisaged under the transfer policy.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submit that the petitioners have already raised the grievance by way of representations/legal notices, which are pending consideration with respondents and the respondents may kindly be directed to decide the said grievance in a time bound manner by passing appropriate and speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Additional A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned State counsel raises no objection to deciding the representations/legal notices which the petitioners have stated to have filed in a time bound manner by passing appropriate and speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case, or the claim being raised by the petitioners in the present petition and in legal notices/representations, a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to

decide the legal notices/representations submitted by the petitioners raising grievance(s) qua their transfer within a period of 8 weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Till the decision on the representations/legal notices, the petitioners be allowed to continue at their present place of posting.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of connected cases.
