Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to issue revised pension payment order after adding the ad hoc service period as computed as per service record sent by the Parent Department to the Accountant General Office.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 28.07.2022 (P-6) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioners, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 28.07.2022 (P-6) by passing reasoned order as per law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
