[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-5, dated 13.01.2022, in CWP-23151-2021 in case titled as '**Randhawa Infrastructure Private Ltd. versus State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-5) reveals that CWP-23151-2021 was disposed of by directing the Director General of Consolidation of Holdings, Haryana, Sector 22, Chandigarh to pass appropriate orders on representations dated 12.12.2020 and 11.01.2021 filed by the petitioner within six weeks and to communicate his decision to the petitioner.

[3] Pursuant to notice issued by this Court, learned Asstt. AG, Haryana, has filed compliance report-cum-reply dated 15.12.2022 along with copy of speaking order (Annexure R-1) dated 13.12.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner for issuing notification for conducting Consolidation in Village Rozka Gujjar, Tehsil Sohna, District Gurugram. The

thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of order (Annexure R-1), he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order (Annexure R-1) dated 13.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
