Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that in the present case, the service benefit in respect of the service rendered by the late husband of petitioner No.1 namely Sh. Kewal were not being released, but during the pendency of the present petition, majority of the benefits have been released, but still certain benefits such as death-cum-retirement gratuity, interest on the delayed release of the pensionary benefit as well as compassionate appointment of petitioner No.2 or financial assistance are pending consideration with the respondent and the petitioner intends to approach the respondent for the release of the same by filing appropriate representation and the respondent may kindly be directed to decide the same within a fixed time frame by passing a speaking order.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any such representation is received from the petitioner raising any claim, the same will be dealt with in accordance with law and appropriate orders will be passed within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of the same and in case, after the decision on the representation, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will be released to them within a period of 4 weeks

thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
