[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 02.06.2022 in CWP No.11772 of 2022 in case titled as Balkaran Singh vs. State of Punjab and another.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that on 02.06.2022, while adjourning the case to 30.08.2022 it was made clear that till the next date of hearing, the respondents were restrained from reducing the pension of the petitioner.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the aforementioned order restraining the respondent from reducing the pension of the petitioner continues to be in force even as on date.

[4] Learned counsel for the respondent has filed short reply by way of affidavit on behalf of the respondent as also the details of payment made to the petitioner on account of the amount which was deducted. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner who on perusal thereof states that in terms of order, Annexure

P/1, pension has to be restored to the level from which it had been reduced and with effect from the date the same had been reduced.

[5] Learned Counsel for the respondent states that the matter would be processed and full pension for the month of May, 2022 released to the petitioner within two weeks.

[6] The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

[7] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while directing the respondent to adhere to the assurance held out by learned counsel to release full pension to the petitioner for the month of May, 2022 within two weeks from today.
