Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was appointed as a Guest Faculty Lecturer in the year 2010 and continued working till the year 2019 after which, her services were dispensed with and thereafter, petitioner has been allowed to join back now in March, 2022 and, therefore, as the relieving of the petitioner in the year 2019 was bad in law, petitioner is entitled to the salary for the period she remained out of service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 02.09.2022 (Annexure P-8) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajesh Gaur, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 02.09.2022 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the legal notice, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 02.09.2022 (Annexure P-8), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
