1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 18.07.2019, in CWP-17514-2017.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 18.07.2019, reveals that CWP-17514-2017, was disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to submit a representation for promotion and in case any such representation was moved by the petitioner, the same was to be decided by the competent authority by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within two and a half months, from the date of receipt of representation, failing which, costs of Rs.50,000/- were to be paid to the petitioner and recovered from the salary of the concerned officer.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that order Annexure P/5 dated 27.08.2019, has been passed by respondent

2017 and the petitioner has been promoted, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
