This is a petition for quashing of FIR No.70 dated 29.04.2016, registered at Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar, Mohali, under Sections 323, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC (later on charge framed under Sections 420 read with Section 120-B, 465 read with Section 120-B, 467 read with Section 120-B, 468 read with Section 120-B, 471 read with Section 120-B, 323 read with Section 120-B IPC), along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 18.09.2019 (Annexure P-3).

Vide order dated 20.02.2020, the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court was directed to record the statements of all concerned parties with regard to the genuineness and validity or otherwise of the compromise.

In compliance thereof, the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali, has submitted a report vide letter dated 14.07.2020, which indicates that none of the parties appeared for recording of their respective statements with regard to the validity of the compromise.

Respondent No.2, who is present in the Court and identified by learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that no compromise has been effected with the petitioners.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he does not want to press the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.
