Prayer in this petition is for quashing the order dated 13.09.2022 passed by the trial Court in case FIR No. 83 dated 17.03.2012, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Zirakpur, District S.A.S. Nagar, vide which bail/surety bonds of the petitioner have been cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR dates back to the year 2012 and the petitioner was granted the concession of bail and was regularly attending the court proceedings and in the intervening period, as many as 63 dates have been taken by the prosecution to lead their evidence, however, the same is still not concluded. It is further submitted that on 13.09.2022, father of the petitioner was seriously ill and he had intimated his counsel in the trial Court but the impugned order was passed before he could reach the Court.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is ready to

surrender before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and apply for grant of fresh bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Navneet Singh, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned State counsel does not dispute the factual position but opposes the bail.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without making any comment on the merits of the case, considering the fact that the FIR pertains to the year 2012; the petitioner was regularly appearing before the trial Court; his non-appearance on the fateful day was not intentional and also in view of the fact that he is ready to surrender before the trial Court, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioner to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and on doing so, the trial Court will release him on bail, subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Till the time the petitioner appears before the trial Court, his arrest shall remain stayed.

However, this will be subject to a condition that the petitioner will deposit a cost of Rs. 3,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, S.A.S. Nagar.
