[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 20.04.2022 in CRM-M No.16020 of 2022 in case titled as Meenakshi vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CRM-M No.16060 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 21.01.2022 filed by the petitioner in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Pursuant to notice issued to the respondent in the instant petition, learned AAG has produced copy of speaking order dated 17.12.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 21.01.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal

of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 17.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instantpetition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
