[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 24.08.2022 in CWP No.17455 of 2022 in case titled as Badal Singh vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.17455 of 2022 was disposed by directing the respondents to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner expeditiously by passing a fresh order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that fresh speaking order has been passed on the appeal filed by the petitioner on 05.12.2022 in compliance of order, Annexure P/1, therefore, in the circumstances, she does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 05.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as

not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
