[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 19.07.2022 in CWP No.7699 of 2022 in case titled as Manoj Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.7699 of 2022 was disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioners to file a comprehensive representation to the respondent raising the grievance as also by taking into account the submission of learned State Counsel that in case any representation was filed by the petitioners raising any grievance, the same would be considered and decided in accordance with law and appropriate order passed within eight weeks of receipt of copy of the representation.

[3] Although notice has not been issued in the instant case, yet learned DAG has produced copy of order dated 01.09.2022 rejecting the claim made in comprehensive representation dated 09.08.2022, Annexure P/2 filed by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof

supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof

states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 01.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instantpetition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
