The petitioner has filed the present petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, his wife and other family members as they apprehend eminent threat at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8.

Mr. Ankush, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4 and filed his memorandum of appearance, which is taken on record.

Mr. Ishan Gupta, Advocate, has put his appearance on behalf of respondents No.5, 6 and 8 and filed his memo of appearance, which is taken on record.

A short reply by way of affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur has been filed on behalf of the official respondents and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing for the State submits that on 07.12.2022, a complaint was made by the petitioner to SHO Police Station Sadar, Sangrur and to maintain peace and order, proceedings under Sections 107 / 151 Cr.P.C were initiated against Nirbhai Singh, Lakhbir Singh and Jugraj Singh vide DDR No.23 dated 09.12.2022 and Nirbhai Singh, Lakhbir Singh and Jugraj Singh were also taken in custody and released on bail in view of the orders passed by SDM Sangrur.

In the meantime, the inquiry was marked to DSP (SD) Sangrur also who visited the site in dispute and on the basis of site visit, facts and issues involved, he recommended for registration of the FIR and on the basis of said recommendations, FIR No.144 dated 13.12.2022, under Sections 447, 511, 427 and 506 of IPC has already been registered against Nirbhai Singh, Lakhbir Singh and two unknown persons. The learned State counsel also submits that every effort shall be made to ensure that law and order is maintained in the area at the site in question.

In view of the above statement, no further orders are required. It is expected that the police shall investigate the matter fairly and in accordance with law after associating both the sides.

The present petition is disposed of.
