The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.276 dated 22.10.2017 (Annexure P1) under Sections 147, 148, 149, 285, 307, 341, 427 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were granted anticipatory/regular bail and had been appearing before the trial Court regularly, but could not appear on one date, as they had noted wrong date. Consequently, their bail was cancelled and bonds were forfeited.

Issue notice to the respondent.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Heard.

Some of the petitioners had been granted anticipatory bail by this

Court in FIR No.276 dated 22.10.2017 (Annexure P1) while others had been granted regular bail by the trial Court. It is stated that they were regularly appearing before the trial Court, but could not appear only on one date when their bail was cancelled and bonds were forfeited, as they had noted wrong date. It would be in the interest of justice if the concession of anticipatory bail is extended to them in the aforementioned facts and circumstances.

Therefore, the petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of ten days and furnish their bail bonds. Henceforth, they shall appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent themselves without the prior permission of the Court.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
