[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 23.08.2022, in CWP-15099-2022.

[2] A perusal of Annexure P-1, reveals that CWP-15099-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner within three months from the next date of hearing i.e. 30.08.2022 and till then operation of order dated 29.04.2019, as per which demolition of the petitioner's residential house was ordered, was ordered to be kept in abeyance.

[3] Although notice has not been issued in this case, yet, learned AAG, Haryana, on instructions states that the case is listed before the respondent on 19.12.2022 and on said date the appeal would be decided and orders passed on the appeal would be conveyed to the petitioner within two weeks thereafter.

[4] The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner, who

states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for issuance of directions to the respondent to ensure adherence to the assurance held out by the learned AAG, Haryana.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while directing the respondent to decide the appeal on the next date of hearing i.e. 19.12.2022 and to convey orders on the same to the petitioner by registered post within two weeks thereafter.
