[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 in CWP-19704-2022.

[2] A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-19704-2022, was disposed of with a direction to the respondent to consider the pending application of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders in respect thereto in accordance with law, preferably within 2 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned AAG, has produced copy of short reply alongwith copy of speaking order Annexure R-1 dated 19.12.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner for issuance of new arms license. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof is stated to have been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner on email id i.e. Adv.amanjoon@gmail.com on 21.12.2022 at 12.24 PM but none is present on behalf of the petitioner. In the circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by adjourning the matter or for that matter by keeping it pending.

[4] In view of the position noted above, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R-1 dated 19.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
