The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case bearing FIR No. 355 of 2019 dated 01.07.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 365 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh.

Reply by way of affidavit of Dharamvir Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Tauru on behalf of respondents No.1 and 5 had been filed as per which the investigation had been undertaken.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State of Haryana has informed in Court today that the investigation in the case has already been concluded. There were a total of 07 persons originally named by the petitioner/victim in the present FIR. However, upon

investigation 04 persons were found to be innocent and the 03 persons against whom material was available were arrested. Investigation is complete and a final report already stands filed in the year 2020 and the case is already fixed for prosecution evidence.

In view of the above, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
