[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/8 dated 01.11.2019 in CWP No.30888 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order Annexure P/8 reveals that CWP No.30888 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the parties to maintain status quo till 25.11.2019 and the Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar was directed to consider the application for stay and to pass appropriate orders on the said date and in case no orders were passed on the said application or the appeal itself, the interim order passed by this Court was to continue till the decision on the application for stay.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that orders, in compliance of orders Annexure P/8 dated 01.11.2019 in CWP No.30888 of 2019 have been passed by the Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the

same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
