This instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to the official respondents to file the status report in a case bearing FIR No.195 dated 06.11.2018 under Section 306 of IPC registered at Police Station Pillu Khera, District Jind and to get the matter investigated from some senior officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police.

In pursuance to notice of motion, fresh status report dated 15.11.2022 by way an affidavit of Sh. Ravi Khundia, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind-Detective, District Jind, has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 7-State. Para 13 of the said report reads as under:-

13. That on 31.10.2020, Umed Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, State Crime Branch, Panchkula found that the allegations levelled in the FIR and suicide note of deceased are false and upon which case file was sent to Station House Officer, Police Station Pillukhera for preparing cancellation report in this case. On 07.11.2020, the Station House Officer, Police Station, Pillukhera has prepared cancellation report in this case and thereafter the same was also filed in the concerned court. The cancellation report was time fixed hearing on 26.09.2022 and further adjourned for 24.11.2022 in the Id. Court of JMIC, Safidon. The relevant order dated 26.09.2022 passed by the Ld. JMIC Safidon is reproduced as under:-

"Complainant has appeared in person and sought an adjournment for further proceeding. Now, the case is adjourned to 24.11.2022 for further proceedings."

Since the cancellation report has already been filed before the trial Court and the complainant has appeared and sought an adjournment for further proceedings, therefore, in view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present case and consequently, the same has been rendered infructuous and disposed off accordingly.
