[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 17.08.2022 in CWP No.12329 of 2022 in case titled as Kailash Kumari vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.12329 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 29.07.2020 in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

[3] Learned DAG has produced copy of order dated 19.12.2022 promoting the petitioner to the post of TGT English, HES-III (School Cadre). The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

[4] At the stage, learned DAG states that there is typographical

error with regard to the scale mentioned in order dated 19.12.2022 and the same would be corrected to show the scale as is admissible as per rules to TGT English HES-III (School Cadre). The same is not opposed by learned counsel for the petitioner who states that in the circumstances, she does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to issue amended order in substitution of order dated 19.12.2022 to reflect the scale as is admissible as per rules to TGT English HES-III (School Cadre). Needful be done within two weeks and copy of amended order be supplied to the petitioner against acknowledgment.
