The prayer in the present petition is for direction to the respondent nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from danger at the hands of private respondent nos.4 to 9. There is a further prayer to direct the respondent nos.1 to 3 to register an FIR under the provisions of SC/ST Act. Still further it is prayed that the representation made by the petitioner to respondent no.2 be acted upon.

The Counsel for the State has filed a response. As per the said response the petitioner and his wife are habitual of making complaints of similar nature against the officers of the government department and the details of the similar complaints are listed at page 2 of the reply. Further it

is submitted that the complaint Annexure P-6 has already been decided and disposed of by the police and the report of the same has been filed by SP, Panipat on 29.10.2019. There is a reference to other complaints as well which have been dealt with in accordance with law. It has also been found that the petitioner does not require protection as sought.

In view of the said reply submitted, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition.

Disposed of.

However, the petitioner is free to avail his alternative remedies in accordance with law.
