[1] Learned AAG on instructions from the Executive Engineer, Public Health Enquiry, Division No.1, Jind states that the petitioner is required to complete formalities whereupon the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 12.07.2022 would be decided within such time as is granted by this Court.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to ensure presence of the petitioner in the office of the respondent on 13.12.2022 at 11.00 A.M.

[3] In the light of the position noted above, necessary formalities be got completed on 13.12.2022 or expeditiously thereafter and claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 12.07.2022 be decided by passing an administrative order in respect thereto in accordance with law within one week thereafter.

[4] The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

[5] Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above, the

instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the

respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while directing the parties to adhere to the assurance as per statement made by respective counsel.

[6] Needless to mention in case needful is not done by the respondent in the manner as indicated above, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
