Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that in the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that the petitioners are working as Edusat Chowkidars in the Government Schools of Haryana for the last so many years but their services have not been regularized by the respondents, which act of the respondents is contrary to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *Secretary, State of Karnataka vs. Uma Devi and others, 2006 (4) SCC 1*.

The further prayer of the petitioners is that appropriate direction be issued to the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already approached the respondents by serving upon them a legal

notice dated 14.10.2022 (Annexure P-2), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice of the petitioners dated 14.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and entitlement of the petitioners in respect of the claim made in the writ petition/legal notice, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 14.10.2022 (Annexure P-2), within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
