The petitioner has filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and their relatives, who are posing eminent threat to her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 01.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur and he shall be satisfied in case, appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and to take decision expeditiously as per law.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, respondent

No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and to take a conscious decision within a period of four weeks, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
