Petitioners have filed this writ petition being aggrieved of the inaction of official respondents in not handing over possession of plots measuring 100 sq. yards, claimed to have been allotted to them on being found eligible.

It is submitted that the petitioners are fully eligible for allotment of plots measuring 100 sq. yards, under the Mahatma Gandhi Rural Development Scheme. Reference is made to the list of eligible persons, Annexure P-5. It is submitted that thereafter, a Resolution/ Draw of Lots, Annexure P-6, was held and plot numbers were assigned to the petitioners. However, till date neither the conveyance deed in respect to the plots, has been executed nor possession of plots handed over to the petitioners. In this respect, petitioners are stated to have served a legal notice dated 07.01.2022, Annexure P-10 upon the Deputy Commissioner and Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Jhajjar, but to no avail.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners restricts the prayer for a decision on his legal notice dated 07.01.2022, Annexure P-10, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl.AG., Haryana, at the asking of Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and does not raise any serious objection to the restricted prayer addressed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, but without expression of any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to take a final decision regarding the allotment of plots to the petitioners and finally decide legal notice dated 07.01.2022, Annexure P-10, in a time bound manner and preferably within four (04) months from receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, claim of the petitioners is accepted, possession of plots consequent to allotment, be handed over to them within two months thereafter.
