HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

The petitioners, who are working as Guest Faculty Teachers, have approached this Court with the grievance that rather than giving them the station of their choice, the respondents are allotting the same to the private respondents, who have been selected by way of contract basis after them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have a preferential right of the station being allotted to them as compared to the newly recruited contractual employees, hence, appropriate direction be issued to the respondents to grant the petitioners the station of their choice in preference to the private respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that without raising any grievance before the Department concerned, the petitioners have filed the present petition, which is not maintainable.

Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case, the petitioners raises any grievance, as raised in the present petition, before the Department concerned by filing a representation, the same will be decided in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents by way of representation.
