The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take legal action against respondents No.4 and 5, who by taking advantage of old age as well as medical conditions of the petitioner, committed fraud and cheating with the petitioner by misappropriating a huge amount of money regarding the property belonging to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel refers to the reply dated 23.09.2021.

Para 3 of the said reply reads as under:-

“That enquiry to said application was entrusted to then ACP Cantonment Jalandhar and during enquiry of the complaint, petitioner suffered statement that he has effected compromise with the other party and also produced compromise deed duly executed between petitioner and private respondents and requested that he do not want any action on his complaint and requested to close the said complaint. Copy of the statement of petitioner is annexed herewith as Annexure R-1/T.”

In view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
