On 07.12.2022, following order was passed:-

“ Learned counsel for the appellant has made a statement that an amount of Rs. 20 lacs out of the remaining amount of Rs. 99 lacs would be paid today itself to the respondents. The remaining amount he will pay in weekly instalments by 30th December, 2022. For this, he prays for a day's accommodation to file an undertaking in Court.

Hearing of the case is deferred to 08.12.2022.

The Court will consider the request of the counsel for the appellant, in case an amount of Rs. 20 lacs is paid today.”

It is admitted by the counsel for the parties that the amount of

Rs. 20 lacs could not be paid by the appellant on the said date i.e. 07.12.2022.

To check the bona-fides of the appellant, the request of the counsel had been accepted but the appellant having failed on that, at the very threshold, we are not inclined to interfere in the present appeal.

The appeal, therefore, stands dismissed.
