The prayer in the petition under Section 439 Cr.PC is for grant of bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.112 dated 13.08.2019 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station City Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

At the very outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that she wishes to withdraw the petition and prays that a direction be issued to the Trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

I have heard counsel for the petitioner.

As many as 04 out of 12 cited prosecution witnesses already stand examined and the petitioner is stated to be in custody since 30.11.2021.

In view of the above, petition is ordered to be dismissed as

withdrawn. However, the Trial Court is directed to conclude the trial within a period of 06 months from the next date of hearing fixed before it.
