1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 11.05.2022, in CWP-9963-2022 and connected matters.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-9963-2022 was disposed of by directing the Regional Transport Authority to decide the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 07.04.2022 by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of decision having been taken on the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated on 07.04.2022 vide order dated 15.12.2022, by the Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Jalandhar, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 15.12.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not
