1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 12.10.2022, in LPA-682-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that while directing the listing of LPA-682-2022 along with LPA-814-2021 and connected matters, the respondents were directed to allow the appellants to work continuously on the post they were holding on the date of judgment of the learned Single Judge till the State made appointment of Lecturers possessing qualification of NET/Ph.D. on regular basis.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the needful having been done in compliance of order Annexure P/1 and the petitioner having been allowed to work on the post, he was holding on the date of judgment by the learned Single Judge, he does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
