MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C for grant of interim regular bail for one month in case FIR No.0005 dated 17.10.2019 registered under Sections 18, 20 and 25 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station State Special Operation Cell, SAS Nagar, District Intelligence Wing, SAS Nagar, Mohali, on medical grounds.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that on 10.08.2022, the petition for regular bail filed by the petitioner was withdrawn as the prosecution had examined all its witnesses, but according to him, the prosecution has moved an application under Section 311 Cr.P.C to summon the DSP Shamsher Singh (Investigating Officer) for re-examination and the said application is pending. Learned counsel has further invited the attention of the Court to the medical status report of the petitioner sent by Medical Officer, District Jail Rupnagar to Superintendent, District Jail, Rupnagar to contend that the petitioner is

suffering from heart ailment and requires treatment. He prays for interim regular bail.

After hearing learned counsel and considering the nature of the case as well as the ailment suffered by the petitioner, this Court finds that as per the medical status report dated 10.10.2022 (Annexure P-16), the petitioner is being examined regularly by the doctors and even on some occasions, he has been taken to the PGI Chandigarh. It is specifically mentioned in the report that the patient is undergoing conservative treatment and will be provided required referral treatment as and when required. Apart from it, the Special Court, SAS Nagar while declining his prayer for grant of interim bail has directed the Jail Superintendent to get the petitioner treated from competent government doctors, thus, in view of the above, no ground is made out for release of petitioner on interim regular bail.

Petition is dismissed.
