VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J.

Prayer in this writ petition is for the issuance of a direction to the respondents to count the service rendered by the petitioner on daily wages as SPO as qualifying service for the purpose of the pensionary/retiral benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that this case is covered by the judgment dated 31.08.2010 (Annexure P-3) and subsequently followed in many other cases including judgment dated 01.06.2022 passed in CWP No.12519 of 2022. Learned counsel submits that the only reason for the denial of benefit to the petitioner is that he had not approached the Court for seeking a similar relief. He also submits that his representation (Annexure P-4) is pending in this regard.

Learned counsel for the parties, are *ad idem* that a direction be issued to the respondents that representation (Annexure P-4) be decided.

In view of the above, the respondents are directed to take a final decision on the representation dated 10.08.2022 (Annexure P-4) within a period of two months from today. The decision on the representation be conveyed to the petitioner.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
