ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of writ in the nature of Certiorari seeking to set aside final result dated 14.11.2022 (Annexure P-3) for the post of Painter of Public Work Department (B&R). Petitioner was non-suited on the ground that he has not acquired essential experience of 2 years. Whereas, petitioner claims of having got work experience of more than two years as a Painter.

2. Pleading case of petitioner is that he had attended the Apprentice training in the Painter Trade with Maruti Suzuki India Limited, Palam Road, Gurugram, which is covered under the Apprenticeship Act of 1961 from 26.09.2014 to 25.09.2015. Copy of National Apprenticeship Certificate is appended with the petition as Annexure P-5. He had also worked as a Painter with Maruti Suzuki India Limited, Gurgaon from 09.04.2016 to 08.11.2016; and again from 16.09.2017 to 15.04.2018. Copy of aforesaid experience certificates are appended with the petition as Annexure P-6 (copy). Petitioner had

completed his Diploma in the trade of Painter General from Government Industrial Training Institute, Bhiwani and got issued certificate (Annexure P-7) on 25.05.2015 by the Department of Industrial Training, Haryana, NCVT, which shows the marks obtained by the petitioner in the Trade Test as 557 out of total 700 marks.

2.1. Pursuant to advertisement No.01/2020 dated 12.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) published by respondent-Haryana Staff Selection Commission for various posts including the post of Painter, category No.9, petitioner applied for the same. He is an ITI diploma holder in the trade of Painter. Written examination was conducted. Final result (Annexure P-3) was declared by respondent No.2 on 14.11.2022, but name of the petitioner did not find mention therein. Candidature of the petitioner was rejected because he was not having essential experience of 2 years. Hence, the present petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and opposes the petition.

5. I have heard rival contentions of learned counsel for the parties and gone through the record.

6. From the record appended with the writ petition, it appears that petitioner was non-suited essentially on the ground of lacking requisite work experience as a Painter, and that too, without making any verification from his previous employer i.e., Maruti Suzuki India Limited, Palam Road, Gurugram. Petitioner has appended a copy of certificate dated 28.09.2015 (Annexure P-5), which reflects that he had undergone an apprenticeship training in the Painter trade from 26.09.2014 to 25.09.2015. Further petitioner has appended a copy of certificate dated 22.06.2022 (Annexure P-6 colly) which reflects that he had

worked as a Painter with Maruti Suzuki India Limited, Gurugram from 09.04.2016 to 08.11.2016; and thereafter, from 16.09.2017 to 15.04.2018. Therefore, *prima facie* it appears that he possesses more than 2 years of work experience as a Painter including one year as an apprentice. Not only that, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the selection to the post of apprenticeship in Maruti Suzuki India Limited, Palam Road, Gurugram was made after written examination as well as after verifying skills of the petitioner in the Painter trade. Petitioner is stated to have worked as a Painter from 09.04.2016 to 08.11.2016; and thereafter, from 16.09.2017 to 15.04.2018 as per his work experience certificate dated 22.06.2022 (Annexure P-6 colly). All that has seemingly not been verified before counting his total experience of 2 years. Had the needful been done, petitioner perhaps would have been found eligible.

7. Be that as it may, writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondents to verify the work experience of the petitioner. In case, it is found that he had indeed rendered work as a Painter, benefit thereof be given to him to determine his eligibility.

8. Needful exercise be carried out within a period of 2 months from today.

9. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
