In the instant petition, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No. 99 dated 15.05.2022, registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga, under Sections 15, 18, 21, 22, 27-A, 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is urged that the co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Jayant Kumar @ Janta Kabadia, Rakesh Mangla @ Rakesh Kumar @ Soni and Rani have been granted anticipatory bail in CRM-M-43521-2022, CRM-M-45697-2022 & CRM-M-46751-2022.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab accepts notice. He has filed custody certificate dated 15.12.2022, in connected case that CRM-M-45566-2022 showing that the co-accused Sheetal, who was arrested alongwith the present petitioner, has undergone 7 months of custody.

Keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances and since the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sufficient time and no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, the prayer made in this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, concerned.
