Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondent-department to grant promotion to the petitioner from the post of Staff Nurse to Nursing Sister from the date junior to her was given promotion i.e. w.e.f. 31.12.2018 with consequential benefits of seniority/fixation of pay and arrears along with interest.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 05.09.2022 (P-11) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 05.09.2022 (P-11) by passing reasoned order as per law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
