Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, for quashing of FIR No.0013 dated 14.05.2019 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Women Police Station, Mohali (Annexure P-1) alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom,

on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Counsel representing respondent No.2-complainant submits that although a compromise was arrived at between the parties, but the complainant-respondent No.2 has been ill-treated and has again been turned out from her matrimonial home. He submits that the complainant is withdrawing her consent for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.
